September	16	High Expectations: Both parent(s) and school encourage the young person to do well.	60%
October	33	Interpersonal Competence: Young person has empathy, sensitivity and friendship skills.	57%
November	3	Other Adult Relationships: Young person receives support from three or more non-parent adults.	59%
December	?	Choose Your Own Asset: Your school gets to pick any asset to focus on this month!	
January	32	Planning and Decision Making: Young person knows how to plan ahead and make choices.	40%
February	27	Equality and Social Justice: Young person places high value on promoting equality and reducing hunger and poverty.	64%
March	25	Reading for Pleasure: Young person reads for pleasure three or more hours per week.	11%
April	9	Service to Others: Young person serves in the community one or more hours per week.	48%
