Month	Asset #	Asset/Explanation	Percentage of Southington students reported having this asset during the 2015/2016 school year
September	21	Achievement Motivation: Young person is motivated to do well in school.	82%
October	35	Resistance Skills: Young person can resist negative peer pressure and dangerous situations.	56%
November	3	Other Adult Relationships: Young person receives support from three or more non-parent adults.	59%
December	??	Choose Your Own Asset: Your school gets to pick any asset to focus on this month!	
January	32	Planning and Decision Making: Young person knows how to plan ahead and make choices.	40%
February	34	Cultural Competence: Young person has knowledge of and comfort with people of different cultural/racial/ethnic backgrounds.	46%
March	25	Reading for Pleasure: Young person reads for pleasure three or more hours per week.	11%
April	9	Service to Others: Young person serves in the community one or more hours per week.	48%
